

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

It has been a wonderfully long flowering season in my greenhouses. My first miniata came out in mid-August and I still had several fresh flowers in early November. I had around 20 first flowering variegates and was most encouraged at my breeding results. Many were 4 years old so that was most pleasing. I got to purchase a few new colours and interesting plants for my collection. And I got to give away, bin or sell a few plants to make room for my growing seedlings. Hopefully you enjoyed spring with your *Clivia* as well.

In November I repot some of my plants and ensure they all have some 6 month slow release fertiliser. I have discovered a few sections in my greenhouses that I think get too much shade in winter and thus reduce their flowering efforts. So, I want to ensure that those that could flower are in the better light positions over winter. Actually, I'm pretty sure that is November and December efforts. I also want to reassess my pollination efforts. It is interesting to see what seeds are developing and also what seeds I really want to continue to maturity.

Our club had a wonderful mid-October visit to one of our club members in the Dandenongs. Around 25 of us saw some wonderful plants and flowers, purchased some plants and had a great afternoon tea together. In our wet spring we got a few hours together without being rained upon. A big thank you to Peter Haeusler for his efforts in preparation and hosting us. Thank you also to those who attended. It was great having many of our new members join us as well. You'll see a couple of photos of the day in the newsletter.

We have some dates out for next year (pending confirmation by the new committee). Of most significant is that we have decided to have our Expo two weeks later at the end of September. We really did struggle this year to have plants out flowering. While it was probably the most difficult season for a while, it was assessed that generally we struggle in mid-September to have plants to display. Wonderfully, we have been able to return to a venue in Burwood we have previously successfully used.
